

Currently I am in an internet technologies class that is devoted to the creation of websites using HTML, XHTML, CSS and Javascript. This book was the "required" reading for the course... unfortunately. This book will provide you with the very, very, very basic skills (if you want to call them that) of web site design. Fonts, floating elements, tables, bullet lists, image maps, basic forms, some CSS, and multimedia (and by multimedia I mean just embedding video/audio into you page).It's all useful information, but for the price... c'mon, give me a break. There is nowhere close to the amount of content that should be in a book of this price. On top of that, I could not stand the layout of the chapters-- It seemed like each chapter was interrupted with a section on "saving and validating your web page"-- with full page, full color graphics, and then it appeared again later in the same chapter.At least the illustrations are decent; good size to them, color, labels for content/directions.This book would be alright... for a high school class.... in a pinch.You can get more comprehensive books on the various topics in this book for a fraction of the cost (for example CSS: The Missing Manual-- \$23, but a good comprehensive guide to CSS WITH tutorials.) If you

need it for a class, well then you have no choice... but seek outside resources if you really want to know what you are doing... that's what I ended up doing
